The City has implemented the CivicReady alert notification system to ensure our community stays informed.

CivicReady allows the City to deliver urgent notifications, emergency instructions, public safety alerts, and other important updates directly to subscribers via email, text, or voicemail. Subscribers can customize their notification preferences and choose from over 100 language options for automatic message translation. Information provided will remain confidential and will not be shared.

Our community has long expressed interest in a Sam's Club, and we're excited to share that the first location in the Mojave River Valley region is on the way! This highly desired addition will bring an exciting new shopping experience to Hesperia.

Sam's Club has purchased a 6.5-acre property at Amargosa Road and Key Pointe Avenue, just west of the I-15. This significant addition enhances Hesperia's growing retail landscape and will provide residents and neighboring communities convenient access to a wide range of high-quality goods and services.

Currently, the project is in the entitlement phase, with the City collaborating closely with Sam's Club through the required approval processes. This investment by Sam's Club reflects the continued appeal of Hesperia as a prime destination for businesses seeking to serve the Mojave River Valley region. Once operational, the new Sam's Club location will contribute to local job creation, increase sales tax revenue, and offer a variety of high-quality goods and services, further strengthening Hesperia's economic development goals.

Updates on project milestones will be shared on the City's website as the development advances.





A Message from the City Manager

As we welcome 2025, I am proud to reflect on Hesperia's progress over the past year. This year brought exciting announcements, including the future addition of Sam's Club and Dutch Bros Coffee, along with other businesses that will enhance Hesperia's retail and dining options. These announcements highlight how Hesperia continues to attract new opportunities for growth and investment.

The Kiss Logistics Center, a 655,468-square-foot manufacturing facility planned west of Highway 395 near Phelan Road, will produce beauty products and create approximately 1,100 construction-related jobs. Once completed, it will bring over 620 permanent full-time jobs to our community, representing a significant investment in Hesperia's economic future.

The City is also moving forward with the installation of a traffic signal at Timberlane Avenue and Main Street. In addition to the new signal, the significant intersection improvements will include new crosswalks, ADA-compliant curb ramps, street widening to add designated turn lanes, and other

utility adjustments to support this much-needed project.

It has been inspiring to see the dedication and investment from participants in the Pride Enhancement Program, whose efforts have made a lasting impact on beautifying our community. Volunteer programs, including the Adopt-A-Street program and community clean-ups, further demonstrate the pride and commitment of Hesperia's residents.
